

**Notice of Proposed Exchange of Property**

***Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

The Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, acting through the Bureau of Forestry, and the Pennsylvania Game Commission are proposing to negotiate an exchange of property interests in Benezette Township, Elk County, Pennsylvania.


Pennsylvania Game Commission proposes to convey 291.43 acres of State Game Lands 311 along the north and south sides of Gray Hill Road just west of Benezette. In return, the Bureau of Forestry proposes to convey 291.43 acres of Elk State Forest that is adjacent to State Game Lands 311 and near the Thunder Mountain Equestrian Trail just north of Benezette. An environmental review was conducted by the Bureau of Forestry regarding the exchange, and the review was approved by the State Forester.

As is the policy of the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, the public is hereby notified of this exchange. A 30-day period for public inquiry and/or comment will be in effect commencing June 6, 2015 and ending July 5, 2015. All oral and/or written comments will become part of the official document used in the final decision process. Written documents are also available regarding the proposed land exchange by request.

If, in the duration of the 30-day comment period, a significant amount of public concern develops, the Secretary of the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources may schedule a public informational meeting.


**General Notes:**

1. This is an interdepartmental transfer between Bureau of Forestry and Pennsylvania Game Commission. Parcel A is to be exchanged for parcel D.
2. Parcel A is currently part of Elk State Forest (Parcel B) and to be transferred now and forever to the Pennsylvania Game Commission (Parcel C), to be considered part of State Game Lands 311.
3. Parcel D is currently part of State Game Lands 311 and to be transferred now and forever to the Bureau of Forestry (Parcel B), to be considered part of Elk State Forest.
4. Title vested in Bureau of Forestry (Parcels A & B) through two purchases. First being Anna M. McCullough, dated May 13th 1932, by volume book 93 page 207. This was an option to purchase, dated December 17th 1931, Bureau of Forestry title brief 228 page 391. Second being The Western Pennsylvania Conservancy, dated August 20th 1998, by deed book 375 page 970.
5. On January 17th 1983, there was a transfer in title to The Western Pennsylvania Conservancy by deed book 236 page 532. This is shown on the Bureau of Forestry Map #2428. On August 20th 1998, these parcels were later re-purchased back from The Western Pennsylvania Conservancy by deed book 375 page 970.
6. Title vested in Pennsylvania Game Commission (Parcel D) through P & N Coal Company, by deed book 534 page 1085.




